Contains peer-reviewed, fulltext articles from more than 8400 academic journals and reference sources, as well as fulltext New York Times content back to 1995. It offers extensive coverage of the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature, and more.

(EBSCOhost) - Indexes and abstracts over 3300 journals in the humanities, social sciences, education, etc. Over 2000 journals are full text.

**Sage Premier**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

SAGE Publications publishes over 460 journals in business, humanities, social sciences, and science, technology and medicine, mostly available from 1999 to present. Many articles have fulltext. Use advanced search to combine more than one term from the article title, author, journal name, keywords, or date published.

## Subject Specific Databases

**ClasePeriodica (Firstsearch Databases)**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

CLASE indexes documents published in Latin American and Caribbean social science and humanities journals, while PERIÓDICA covers science and technology journals. They offer access to more than 300,000 bibliographic citations (no abstracts) from over 2,600 scholarly journals.

**Columbia International Affairs Online**<http://www.ciaonet.org/>

(CIAO) publishes theory and research in international affairs from 1991 onward, including working papers, policy briefs, case studies, books, and journals, with some full text.

**Foreign Affairs**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/libdemos.htm>

Note: Only available from on-campus. Foreign Affairs is a premier publication in international relations, political science, and economics. Users can browse and search digital archives ranging from current issues back to 1973. Access will last indefinitely.

**Handbook of Latin America Studies**<http://memory.loc.gov/hlas/>

The Handbook of Latin American Studies is a bibliography on Latin America. Each year over 5,000 works are selected for inclusion in the Handbook. Disciplines covered are anthropology, art, economics, electronic resources, geography, government and politics, international relations, literature, music, philosophy, and sociology.

**HAPI: Hispanic American Periodicals Index**<http://hapi.ucla.edu/>

Subject/author index to articles, bibliographies, documents, literary works, and reviews on U.S. Hispanics and on Latin America, 1970-. HAPI contains some fulltext links and can be limited by Spanish or English language.

**JSTOR**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

Provides access to over 200 full text scholarly journals in the social sciences and humanities, including mathematics, statistics, economics and finance, and ecology.

**MLA Bibliography**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

Contains bibliographic records relating to literature, language, linguistics, poetry and folklore from 1963 to present.

**Project Muse**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

Provides access to over 220 full text humanities and social science journals published by Johns Hopkins University.

**Teacher Reference Center**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

TRC indexes over 260 titles and provides coverage on key education topics such as assessment, continuing education, current pedagogical research, curriculum development, instructional media, language arts, literacy standards, science and mathematics, and more.

## Ebsco A to Z

### Do we have that Journal Full Text?

Ebsco A-to-Z indicates which of Carthage's electronic databases contains full text of a particular journal issue and also provides a hyperlink to the title. Each journal listing in Ebsco A-to-Z contains one or more hyperlinked databases, which can connect you directly to the periodical title you're seeking. If the journal is not on this list, you must use Interlibrary Loan.
