EbscoHost Databases - Biomedical Reference Collectio

Designed for doctors, research scientist, students and clinical specialists, this database provides full text for over 100 journals in a variety of areas pertaining to medical study. All titles included in the Biomedical Reference Collection: Basic Edition are indexed in MEDLINE.

(EBSCOhost) - Indexes and abstracts over 3300 journals in the humanities, social sciences, education, etc. Over 2000 journals are full text.

Basic Biosis

Indexes over 300 basic core like journals from the most current five years.

(FirstSearch) - Indexes life science information from over 300 sources from 1989 to present.

GPO (Government Printing Office)<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

The GPO covers a variety of U.S. government documents, including congressional reports, hearings, and records, judiciary materials, and documents issued by executive departments. Coverage is from 1976 to present.

Ingenta<http://www.ingentaconnect.com/>

Indexes over 27,000 periodicals in the physical and applied sciences, humanities, and social sciences. There is no full text.

JSTOR<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

Provides access to over 200 full text scholarly journals in the social sciences and humanities, including mathematics, statistics, economics and finance, and ecology.

Medline<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/alljournals.htm>

World's largest biomedical database containing over 8 million references to journal articles in all areas of medicine and related disciplines from 1966 to present. Search the database of MEDLINE journal title abbreviations and their corresponding full titles.

Provides access to over 220 full text humanities and social science journals published by Johns Hopkins University.

Interlibrary Loan**InterLibrary Loan**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/interlibraryloan.htm>

Interlibrary Loan is available to request materials that are not owned by Hedberg Library from other libraries. There is no charge for loans to Carthage students, faculty, and staff. The average time needed for Interlibrary Loan transaction is 7-14 days. To avoid delays, always check the Carthage Catalog and EBSCO A-Z before submitting requests. Ebsco A to Z**Do we have that Journal Full Text?**<http://www.carthage.edu/ais/library/ebscoaz.htm>

Ebsco A-to-Z indicates which of Carthage's electronic databases contains full text of a particular journal issue and also provides a hyperlink to the title. Each journal listing in Ebsco A-to-Z contains one or more hyperlinked databases, which can connect you directly to the periodical title you're seeking. If the journal is not on this list, you must use Interlibrary Loan.
