(EBSCOhost) - Indexes and abstracts over 3300 journals in the humanities, social sciences, education, etc. Over 2000 journals are full text.

Sage Premier

SAGE Publications publishes over 460 journals in business, humanities, social sciences, and science, technology and medicine, mostly available from 1999 to present. Many articles have fulltext. Use advanced search to combine more than one term from the article title, author, journal name, keywords, or date published.

MAS Ultra - School Edition

Designed specifically for high school libraries, this database contains full text for more than 500 popular high school magazines. MAS Ultra School Edition also provides more than 360 full text reference books, 85,630 biographies, 104,481 primary resource documents, and an Image Collection of 285,912 photos, maps, and flags, color PDFs and expanded full text backfiles, (back to 1975) for key magazines.

Middle Search Plus

Middle search plus provides full text for more than 140, popular, middle school magazines. All full text articles included in the database are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles). Full text is also available for thousands of biographies and historical essays. Middle Search Plus also contains 85,639 biographies, 104,481 primary source documents, and an image collection of 285,912 photos, maps, and flags.

Primary Search

Primary search provides full text for nearly 70 popular magazines for elementary school research. All full text articles included in this database are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles) and full text information dates as far back as 1990.

Designed for professional educators, this database provides a highly specialized collection of 520 high quality education journals, including nearly 350 peer reviewed titles. This database also contains more than 200 education reports.

This database provides full text coverage for almost 400 leading journals in the field. It covers not only the literature on primary, secondary and higher education, but also special education, home schooling, adult education, and hundreds of related topics.

Contains more than 40,000 articles from 53 journals from 1985 to present.

Ebsco A-to-Z indicates which of Carthage's electronic databases contains full text of a particular journal issue and also provides a hyperlink to the title. Each journal listing in Ebsco A-to-Z contains one or more hyperlinked databases, which can connect you directly to the periodical title you're seeking. If the journal is not on this list, you must use Interlibrary Loan.
