CQ Electronic Library provides access to CQ Researcher Online and CQ Weekly. CQ Researcher provides in-depth coverage of political and social issues, with regular reports on topics in health, education, the environment, technology, the U.S. economy and international affairs. CQ Weekly covers what is happening in the U.S. Congress, including the status of bills, votes, committee activity, backroom maneuvering, etc.

(EBSCOhost) - Indexes and abstracts over 3300 journals in the humanities, social sciences, education, etc. Over 2000 journals are full text.

Sage Premier

SAGE Publications publishes over 460 journals in business, humanities, social sciences, and science, technology and medicine, mostly available from 1999 to present. Many articles have fulltext. Use advanced search to combine more than one term from the article title, author, journal name, keywords, or date published.

(CIAO) publishes theory and research in international affairs from 1991 onward, including working papers, policy briefs, case studies, books, and journals, with some full text.

Contemporary Women's Issues

Provides access to full text information on women from over 150 countries from the disciplines of psychology, health, education, and human rights.

Econ Lit (Firstsearch)

Indexes journal articles, books, and working papers dealing with economics. Contains more than 700,000 records with coverage from 1969 to present.

Ethnic News Watch

Foreign Affairs

Note: Only available from on-campus. Foreign Affairs is a premier publication in international relations, political science, and economics. Users can browse and search digital archives ranging from current issues back to 1973. Access will last indefinitely.

GPO (Government Printing Office)

The GPO covers a variety of U.S. government documents, including congressional reports, hearings, and records, judiciary materials, and documents issued by executive departments. Coverage is from 1976 to present.

JSTOR

Provides access to over 200 full text scholarly journals in the social sciences and humanities, including mathematics, statistics, economics and finance, and ecology.

Military and Government Collection

Designed to offer current news pertaining to all branches of the military and government, this database offers a thorough collection of periodicals, academic journals, and other content pertinent to the increasing needs of those sites. The Military & Government Collection provides cover-to-cover full text for nearly 300 journals and periodicals and indexing and abstracts for nearly 400 titles.

Do we have that Journal Full Text?

Ebsco A-to-Z indicates which of Carthage's electronic databases contains full text of a particular journal issue and also provides a hyperlink to the title. Each journal listing in Ebsco A-to-Z contains one or more hyperlinked databases, which can connect you directly to the periodical title you're seeking. If the journal is not on this list, you must use Interlibrary Loan.
