10 business days

PI submits PART B- Authorization to Submit

- Dean/Provost/CFO- Review & authorize proposal
- **OSP-** Reviews & finalizes proposal package & compliance requirements



1 month BEFORE deadline

PI submits draft of budget to OSP for review

- PI submits budget to Office of Sponsored Programs
- Budget information should include content required by the funder as well as an outline of any Carthage commitments
- The Grants Administrator and Grants Accountant will review budget information and work with PI to resolve



Typically 1 month before deadline

PI prepares proposal & PART B- Authorization to Submit
This process will include the development of: Narrative,
institutional impacts, budget, bio-sketch, resources and other
proposal documents



Typically 2 months before deadline

Once authorization to pursue the funding is received:

- OSP- Reviews sponsor guidelines and prepares PI work-plan
- **PI-** Begins proposal development



Typically 3-6 months before deadline

Once a PI identifies a funding sources

- **PI** Completes & submits PART A- Intent to Purse via the MY GRANT PORTAL.
- PART A is approval is provided by the Dean or VP. This approval allows the PI to begin developing their proposal



At any time

PI searches for funding sources

Office of Sponsored Programs can serve as a resource



At any time

PI submits Grant Project Idea Form to OSP

PI begins discussions with their Chair, Dean or VP about their idea and initiates work with Office of Sponsored Programs

10-Business Day Deadline for Proposal Submission

Electronic proposal submission can be a complex endeavor. It is the responsibility of the Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP) to ensure that all proposals conform to College and sponsor guidelines and policies. The OSP is instituting a 10 working day internal deadline for the receipt of a complete proposal.

A complete submission is a proposal that is submitted to OSP, contains finalized administrative components (budget, institutional impacts, bio-sketch, resources, etc.), a draft technical section (research plan), all compliance forms, and has approved budget.

OSP can not assure a full review or timely submission of proposals that are not received 10 business days prior to the sponsor deadline.
