What We Are Doing This Month

Moon Shot Best Practice Team Leaders are holding team meetings: (1) to understand the state of the problem for each best practice and (2) to establish objectives based on problems identified. Teams will accomplish this through conversations internal and external to campus, data analyses, and student and staff focus groups.

In order to foster collaborative learning across the region, we are hosting cross institutional team meetings. Attendees of the meetings are expected to share out updates of best practices, ask and learn from others and talk about the impact of team efforts on other best practice teams.

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Navigate SSMS Technology Update



Each Partner will implement:

- Cappex Digital Recruitment Software
- Navigate Student Success Management System
- Prospective Student Portal*

The implementation of these will enable: (1) Common Data storing practices, (2) Common Support Structure for students transferring within the region, (3) Common analytic dashboards to tailor interventions based on student needs, and (4) Shared Links on Prospective Student Portal. Each Partner is at different stages of maturity with Navigate SSMS, see updates below.

UW-Parkside has continued to use Navigate in strategic ways to support students across the 2020-2021 Academic Year. UWP recently concluded its second semester of using Progress Reports to capture feedback in key courses and on specific student populations and found that students who received case management intervention in response showed stronger spring retention rates than their peers. In addition, UWP students have received proactive support through appointment campaigns, timely text messages, Navigate Student quick polls, and access to streamlined appointment scheduling. Looking ahead, UWP is planning for its upcoming launch of Academic Planning in addition to expanding its Coordinated Care Network through the strengthening and onboarding of additional care units.


UW Milwaukee As one of the Student Success Collaborative's longstanding partners, UW-Milwaukee has continued to refine their use of proactive campaigns and progress reporting to support students. UW-Milwaukee currently has four care units in Navigate that employ self-service student scheduling: advising, coaching, peer mentoring, and tutoring.

In the upcoming academic year, UW-Milwaukee will focus on further expanding this coordinated care network and subsequently refining referral alerts to better connect students to appropriate resources. In addition, UW-Milwaukee is in the process of building out functionality for their Academic Planner and will be launching it to a pilot group next Fall. Milwaukee Area Technical College is scheduled to launch their Phase 1 Navigate functionality to staff and students at the beginning of May, with trainings scheduled across the month for key stakeholders. Entering into Fall 2021, MATC will focus on building adoption of appointment scheduling, note taking, proactive campaigns, as well as early alert workflows. MATC's data centered intervention team is currently building out their early alert workflows for both progress reporting and referrals.

Carthage College Carthage College is scheduled to launch Navigate to pilot staff users in June and faculty/students in August. Trainings will be scheduled in June for Center for Student Success, Aspire, Registrar, and Student Financial Services colleagues. More communication for faculty/students around August trainings is forthcoming. Key components of Navigate on which Carthage will focus include building appointment scheduling, interaction documentation, proactive outreach, and early alerts – all to enhance and strengthen Carthage's [Holistic Advising Model](#).
