

Hello Carthage Students,

This is a reminder that deadlines are quickly approaching and you may be eligible to receive Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations ACT (CRRSAA) financial aid relief grant funds. Determining your eligibility is dependent on multiple factors including financial need; as determined by a valid FAFSA.

To determine your eligibility prior to the Fall 2021 tuition due date **Wednesday 07/28/2021** you must complete the financial aid process by **Thursday 06/17/2021**. A completed financial aid process includes:

- Submitting a valid FAFSA (*Students ineligible to submit a FAFSA may still be eligible to receive CRRSAA funds.*)
- Submitting additional documentation requested by the Office of Student Financial Services
- Completing your online Check-In process (beginning 05/13/2021)
- To view your missing documents, log on to your my.carthage.edu portal. After clicking on the Finances tab, you will click on "View Financial Aid Document Tracking." Ensure that you change the award year to "2021-2022 Academic Year" and then your missing documents will be listed towards the bottom of the screen.

CRRSAA provides financial aid grants to students with significant financial need to assist with paying for costs associated with college attendance or emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus pandemic – such as tuition, food, housing, healthcare or child-care. Priority will be given to students who demonstrate high unmet financial need and to students and families who have appealed to the Office of Student Financial Services due to loss of income.

If you have previously completed the steps listed above there is no current action to take.
