# Instructions for Laboratory Animal Research CITI training

#### HAVE AN EXISTING CITI ACCOUNT

- 1. Go to: https://about.citiprogram.org/en/homepage/
- 2. Login & Click on COURSES, make sure Carthage is listed as your organization, then click on VIEW COURSES
- 3. Click on VIEW COURSES, Scroll to the bottom, Click on ADD A COURSE
- 4. Skip to #6 (Step 7) listed below in green-- THIS IS CRITICAL

### **NEED TO SET UP A CITI ACCOUNT**

- 1. Go to: https://about.citiprogram.org/en/homepage/
- 2. Click Register
- 3. Select Carthage College as your organization
- 4. Agree to the term of service and privacy policy (you can go and read those)
- 5. Create a login (follow the prompts Steps 2-6)
  - Step 2- Name and email
  - Step 3- Username, password & security question
  - Step 4- Country of residence
  - Step 5- CEU, respond as you prefer
  - Step 6- Demographics questions, respond as you see fit
- 6. Step 7 IS CRITICAL-- It will determine the courses to which you will be given access.

## Only select those noted below...

- Q1: Human subjects research Do not select anything or select "not at this time"
- Q2: Institutional or Signatory Official or IRB Chair Do not select anything
- Q3: Good Clinical Practice Do not select anything or select "not at this time"
- Q4: Information privacy security Do not select anything or select "I am not required to complete at this time"
- Q5: Responsible conduct Do not select anything or select "not at this time"
- Q6: Conflict of Interest Select "NO"
- Q7: Laboratory animal research CLICK ALL APPROPRIATE BOXES
- Q8: Public Health Research Select "Not at this time"
- Q9: IRB committee <u>Select "Not at this time"</u>
- Q10: Essentials of Research Administration Select "no"
- You can go back into your CITI profile at any time and change your responses to Q1-10, your responses will add course selections to MY COURSES profile
- 7. Complete Registration
- 8. Now, once you log into your CITI account go to the Main Menu/My Courses Tab
  - Click on the IACUC related courses and complete
  - The CITI system has a save function and will allow you to leave and come back to finish later
  - You will be required to complete each module at an 80% level
- 9. How to save your training certificate
  - Upon completion CITI will provide you with a certificate for completion of each course
  - Download and save the certificate as a PDF for your records
