Dear Carthage Community,

The arrival of this day brings me great pleasure and pride. Our celebration of student and faculty research, scholarship, and creative work puts the spotlight on our most fundamental values and efforts as a college. While I do not know the specific experience of each of the students in conducting this work represented in the Celebration of Scholars this year, my own experiences over the years make clear that it is highly likely that they struggled, they invested more time than they imagined they would, and that the project took on new forms and greater depth than they first imagined it would. And, that it was these steps taken that one did not at first imagine taking when much of the learning and growth took place. Let us celebrate it all!

One of the fundamental features of this student and faculty work is what it is not. It is not done instantaneously, for example, with a tap on a touch screen! It is slow, thoughtful, and in most cases marked much more by failure than success. Most often, for example, it is only by writing a poor paragraph or page that one can get to a good paragraph or page. The work of scientific work most commonly progresses by a failed experiment that leads to a new set up or adjustment that leads to a success or, the failure itself provides the needed information for a completely new approach to the object of study. The creative expressions of the musician, the theatrical performer, and the artist all progress through practice, rehearsal, and return after return to the same canvas or material object under construction. In our day of having so much at our fingertips and so much that is instantaneous, these slow cook efforts are notable and incredibly important learning experiences for our students. Dare I say that most of what is truly good and productive in this world is produced in this slow cook method? Well, I just said it. Perhaps you agree and perhaps not.

Second, I love this event because it gives students the opportunity to stand and deliver. That is, they are present as we the curious make our way from project to project. And, it is natural and enjoyable to ask questions and listen to students explain what they have done, how they did it, and the significance of the work and the meaning they have made from it. This too is a life skill in formation. The faculty sponsor is likely not present or if they are, they are at a distance, allowing the student to shine. This is a flip the script moment for students as so much of the time it is the faculty member who is in this role. But not today, no it is the student who will bring clarity and meaning to the presentation if it is to happen. Wonderful!

I hope you enjoy the day as much as I know I will. Please join me in congratulating the students and faculty who are presenting this wonderfully rich range of scholarship, research, and creative work. These are some Carthaginians!
