WHAT IS A TOPIC SENTENCE?



A topic sentence is a sentence at the beginning of a body paragraph that introduces what you will be discussing in that paragraph.

WHAT'S IN A TOPIC SENTENCE?



A topic sentence contains any points or ideas that support your thesis and acts as a transition between previous ideas.

EXAMPLE

Thesis Statement: Having a pet is an accessible and effective outlet to relieve stress.

Body Paragraph 1 (About Accessibility)

Given the variety of domesticated animals, anyone looking for a pet can find one that fits in their price range and home environment.

The topic sentence...

- -is specific
- -connects back to the thesis
- -provides an idea of what the following paragraph will cover
