Methodology: This Infographic tracks incoming fall full-time transfer students, based on the fall census. The behavior of transfer students varies greatly from first-time freshmen. For example, transfer students entering a fall transfer cohort have a wide variety of earned credits and can be freshman students or high-ranking students. This creates large variances of actual semesters needed to graduate for each individual student comprising this population. Ten year retention averages have been used to attain a high-level picture of overall activity. Years 2013 to 2017 have been used to create an average six-year graduation rate.
