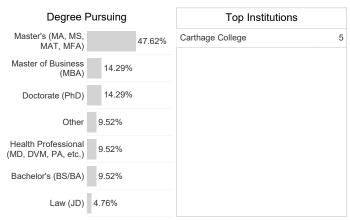

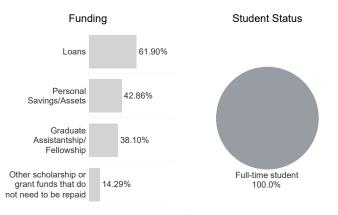

Methodology: All populations include graduating seniors immediately prior to graduation and six months after graduation using a survey designed with the Qualtrics platform. Survey data is analyzed by Carthage staff members from The Aspire Center. The knowledge rate is determined by the number of students who complete the survey divided by the total number of matriculated undergraduate students during the academic year. The positive outcome rate is defined as students who report being employed, attending graduate school, entering the military, or serving in a full-time role with a non-profit organization.
