		Participate and complete the personal statement workshop in the fall semester.
		Stay involved in both the Carthage community and experiential learning opportunities.
		Register and take the Graduate Records Exam (GRE).
		Continue to shadow vets from a wide variety of settings.
		Participate and complete the interview workshop in the spring semester.
		Gather all required letters of recommendations for your application giving at least 2-3 months advance notice for writing.
		Double check dates and deadlines for application materials to your selected vet school.
		VMCAS will open in January and all materials should be submitted in the spring.

		Continue to prepare for potential interviews.
		Monitor VMCAS for any supplemental materials or admissions next steps.
